NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Singchang Pty Ltd of 1/15 Hamilton Street, Osborne Park WA 6017, has lodged with the Director of Liquor Licensing an application to add, vary or cancel a condition of the permit, pursuant to s 64 of the *Liquor Control Act 1988* ("the Act").

The licensee is seeking to:

- a) extend authorised trading for an extra hour, from the approved 12 midnight to 1:00am; thereby closing at 2:00am.

Advertising of Application

The Director of Liquor Licensing ("DLL") has required this application to be advertised in accordance with the *Liquor Control Act 1988* ("the Act") and has specified the period during which submission may be made.

- Objection; or
- General submission in support of, or in opposition to, the application.

Grounds for Objection

An objection must clearly set out the reasons why the grant of the application would:

- Not be in the public interest; or
- Cause undue harm or ill health to people due to the consumption of liquor; or
- Result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to persons in the vicinity; or
- Otherwise be contrary to the Act.

Important Information

- Submissions may be provided to the applicant, who will be given an opportunity to respond.
- Only submissions lodged by the submission deadline will be considered (subject to the Act).
- Submissions should include sufficient detail to support any claims made.
