






Differential rates and minimum payments

Lessons learned comparative report 2024


The Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries (DLGSC) published an infographic at the conclusion of the 2022 and 2023 differential rates and minimum payment application period. This data has been utilised and measured against the 2024 data.

Comparison of processing times



In comparison to last year, DLGSC achieved similar processing times:

One extra day to complete an application following a request for extra information.

Zero change of days to acknowledge receipt of the application received.

Zero change of days to notify the applicant of approval.

Highlights in comparison to 2023

34% more local governments submitted their application(s) online.

100% of local governments provided sufficient Objects and Reasons for each rating category.

7% more local governments provided their responses to their ratepayers' submissions.

14% more local governments provided all 4 forms of public notice with their applications.

10% more local governments were compliant with the Give Notice Policy.
