

## RULES FOR PLAYING IN BETWEEN (PRIVATE )

1. **In Between** shall be played on a layout mat marked in a manner similar to that shown in the diagram:-

IN BETWEEN 2-1

Consecutive Cards 2-1 3 of a kind pays 3-1						

- 2. **In Between** shall be played with a minimum of 4 decks of cards less the jokers with backs of the same colour and design. All cards shall be dealt from a dealing shoe.
- 3. A dealer shall be responsible for the conduct of the game. The dealer shall control the game and not permit any players to handle the cards.
- 4. The Dealer shall not be permitted to wager on the game.
- 5. A maximum of three cards will be dealt to each player.
- The value of cards contained in each deck shall be as follows:-
  - All cards from the 2 to the King shall have their normal order of value and the Ace shall always be High in value, i.e. the Ace cannot be counted as a 1.
- 7. Prior to the first card being dealt for each round of play each player shall place a wager against the dealer in that area of the layout marked with a box.
- 8. Once all wagers have been placed in the appropriate boxes the dealer shall deal each player one card face up followed by a second card face up. The dealer shall then deal a third card to each player in turn to determine a result.
- 9. A player shall win if the value of the third card drawn is in between that of the first and second cards drawn. If the third card is of the same value as the first or second cards the player loses. A winning hand of **In Between** shall be paid at odds of 2 to 1.
- 10. Where a player is dealt two identical cards (a pair) the dealer shall deal a third card. If the third card is the same as the first two the player shall win and be paid at the odds of 3 to 1.
- 11. Where a player is dealt two cards in sequence (3 and 4, queen and King) a third card will be dealt and if a sequence (straight) is continued the played shall win and paid at odds of 2 to 1.
- 12. After the shoe of cards is dealt the cards shall be shuffled.
- 13. New decks of cards shall be introduced when:-
  - (a) a majority of players request a change; or
  - (b) if a card or cards become mutilated.



## RULES FOR PLAYING IN BETWEEN (private) (continued...)

- 14. Before introducing new decks of cards the dealer shall prove to the satisfaction of all players that:-
  - (a) the decks being replaced are complete; and
  - (b) the new decks are complete.
- 15. The dealer shall invalidate the outcome of any round of play if it is established that the decks in use contain an incorrect number of cards.
- 16. The minimum and maximum permitted wagers shall be prominently displayed on a sign at the table.
- 17. The odds payable for winning wagers are to be displayed at the table.
- 18. Persons under the age of 18 years shall not be permitted to play in the game or be involved in the dealing or the conduct of the game.
