Note: By completing this application form, you may be issued with a Banned Drinker Order (BDO) and you may be recorded on the Banned Drinkers Register (BDR), prohibiting you from purchasing take-away liquor until your BDO expires or you request a revocation.

 - It may take up to 2 working days for this request to be processed
- I declare that I am the person whose details appear on this application
- I understand that whilst a BDO is in force, I am liable to a penalty of up to \$2,000 if I obtain, or attempt to obtain packaged liquor, or enter a licensed premises for the purpose of purchasing packaged liquor, within a BDA - s110(4) and (5) *Liquor Control Act 1988*
