

## What is KidSport?

KidSport helps Western Australian children take part in eligible community sports and activities by offering up to \$300 towards the cost of joining a KidSport club.

## Eligibility criteria

- aged 5 to 18 years
- named on a valid Health Care or Pensioner Concession card issued by Centrelink
- resident of Western Australia.

## Become a KidSport approved club

Help more families and children experience the benefits of community sport, activities or swimming lessons.

KidSport clubs can:

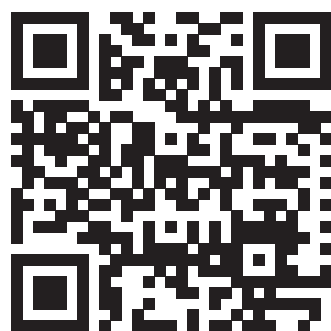
- redeem vouchers as payment for club fees

## How to apply

Applications are open year-round and can be completed online in 3 simple steps.

- 1 Check child eligibility
- 2 Find a KidSport approved club
- 3 Submit an application

Applications will be assessed within 10 working days.

Approved applicants are sent a voucher code. This can be given to a KidSport club to pay registration/membership fees. Your club may also accept vouchers as payment for uniform and equipment costs.



## Further information

- maximum of \$300 per child per financial year can be split over multiple clubs
- check your child's eligibility [cits.wa.gov.au/kidsport](https://cits.wa.gov.au/kidsport)
- if the club fees are more than the approved voucher amount, parents will need to pay the difference
- vouchers expire after 90 days
- clubs will collect the approved voucher during registration at point of payment.

## KidSport special considerations

Special consideration applications are available to support identified low-income families who may have difficulty accessing concession cards or independently applying for a KidSport voucher.

You, or a family you know, may be eligible if they are:

- a family experiencing significant financial distress
- a family impacted by natural disaster
- a child living in the care of extended family or alternate long-term living arrangements
- children in the care of the State in any care arrangement
- a biological child of foster and family carers
- target 120 program participants
- a child or their parent/guardian is an asylum seeker, refugee, or other humanitarian entrant.
